Why do behaviours occur?

Behaviour is functional, and there is always a reason behind it. Each time a person engages in a behaviour, they are trying to communicate something.

For example, a person might scream. Screaming may be their way of saying, "this environment is too hot".

People with communication differences may use behaviours of concern when they do not have the words, skills, or tools to express what they need or what is happening for them.
